RACE Response Definitions from Homeless Management Information Systems (HMIS) Data Standards Revised Draft Notice (July 2009)

HUD defines the following categories of race:

- American Indian or Alaska Native is a person having origins in any of the original peoples of North and South America, including Central America, and who <u>maintains tribal affiliation</u> or community attachment.
- Asian is a person having origins in any of the original peoples of the Far East, Southeast Asia or the Indian subcontinent including, <u>for example</u>, Cambodia, China, India, Japan, Korea, Malaysia, Pakistan, the Philippine Islands, Thailand and Vietnam.
- **Black or African American** is a person having origins in any of the black racial groups of Africa. Terms such as "Haitian" can be used in addition to "Black or African American."
- Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander is a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Hawaii, Guam, Samoa or other Pacific Islands.
- White is a person having origins in any of the original peoples of Europe, the Middle East or North Africa.
- **Don't Know** is a person who does not know their origins.
- **Refused** is a person who refuses to identify their race.
